Summit Christian Academy is a classical Christian school that was founded in 1996. Today it serves more than 250 students in grades K4-12. Our Grammar stage is comprised of grades K5 - 6th, while grades 7-9 form our Dialectic stage and grades 10-12 make up our Rhetoric stage. Our mission is to partner with parents to educate and disciple young men and women through a Christian and classical education. Our classical method is rooted in the Trivium: the grammar, logic, and rhetoric of all subjects. Students who are trained this way are equipped with tools to analyze, think critically, problem solve, and communicate well.

At Summit Christian Academy, we believe that education is meant to do more than train a student for their college and career. We believe, like the ancient Greeks, that education was meant to pass down culture and traditions to young men and women with the hopes of molding them into productive and engaged citizens. As a Christian school, we believe this is best done in conjunction with a Biblical worldview rooted in scripture. It is our desire and by God's Grace alone, that graduates of Summit Christian Academy will be culturally engaged, Christ followers who are eloquent communicators, intellectually curious, and faithful servants.

CLASSICAL CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Summit's classical Christian education is built on a foundation of Latin, logic, integrated liberal arts, and a classically tailored math and science that is designed to address the stages of development. In each grade, students are taught how to learn, equipping them to discern truth, articulate their faith, and serve others for the glory of Jesus Christ.

Latin instruction at Summit begins in 3rd grade and continues through 8th grade. In 9th grade, students have the choice to continue with Latin, or begin studying Spanish.

Summit equips students with the tools necessary to reason, understand arguments, and persuade eloquently. Our classical studies department includes courses that are unique to classical education and build upon one another as our students progress through the dialectic and rhetoric stages of the trivium. In 8th grade, all students take a logic course which is followed by debate in 9th grade. In 10th grade, all students take speech which is followed by a research course in 11th grade. Upon completing all classical studies courses, our seniors are prepared to research, write, present, and eloquently defend a 15-20 page contestable topic of their choice. Each senior is challenged to take a biblical worldview stance on the topic and defend both sides of the issue in an engaging oral presentation.

HONORS & DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAMS

Summit uses a 4.0 grading scale for all Standard courses, and a 4.5 scale for Honors courses offered at the Upper School:

English (9th-12th Grade, Survey/World/American/British Lit.)

Math (Precalculus, Calculus, Statistics, & College Algebra)

History (U. S. History, Sociocultural Studies/Economics)

Science (Chemistry, Physics)

Classical & Modern Languages (Latin/Spanish)

Classical Studies (Thesis)

Electives (Fine Arts, Literature)

Dual enrollment courses are also offered to juniors and seniors through Virginia Peninsula Community College in Math, English, and Sociocultural Studies.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Summit offers sports at the JJV, JV, and Varsity levels for volleyball, soccer, cross country, swimming, basketball, tennis, and golf. Other student activities include STEM Club, Culinary Club, The Gardening Club, National Debate and Speech Association, Spanish/Latin clubs, Student Council, Theater Arts productions, Yearbook, and various Fine Arts classes.

DIPLOMA OPTIONS

Three diplomas are available:

The Basic Diploma (22 credits) is designed to accommodate students with learning difficulties while maintaining high academic expectations.

The Standard Diploma (28 credits) provides rigor to ensure quality college preparation.

The Advanced Diploma (30 credits) is designed for students who desire to be challenged and seek further education at a deeper level. Students are required to take four years of science, math, English, and history; three years of a single classical or modern language; and four Honors core courses including at least two in the same subject.
